


You can also integrate with services via our SMS API. See API documentation here.

You can select one of the native integrations (Procore, Zoom, or GoToWebinar), or you can select the Zapier option to integrate with thousands of other apps via Zapier.

Upon clicking on the Zapier option (or one of its affiliated integrations), you'll be prompted to enter your Zapier credentials or to create a Zapier account for free in order to get started.

You'll then be able to set up your desired integration right there within your online dashboard.

Connect Mobile Text Alerts to hundreds of other apps with Zapier

Zapier lets you connect Mobile Text Alerts to 1,000+ other web services. Automated connections called Zaps, set up in minutes with no coding, can automate your day-to-day tasks and build workflows between apps that otherwise wouldn't be possible.

Each Zap has one app as the **Trigger**, where your information comes from and which causes one or more **Actions** in other apps, where your data gets sent automatically.

Getting Started with Zapier

Sign up for a free <u>Zapier</u> account, from there you can jump right in. To help you hit the ground running, there are some pre-made Zaps you can try.

How do I connect Mobile Text Alerts to Zapier?

- 1. Log in to your **Zapier account** or create a new account.
- 2. Navigate to "Connected Accounts" from the top menu bar.
- 3. Now click on "Connect new account" and search for "Mobile Text Alerts"
- 4. Use your credentials to connect your Mobile Text Alerts account to Zapier.

5. Once that's done you can start creating an automation! Use a pre-made Zap or create your own with the Zap Editor. Creating a Zap requires no coding knowledge and you'll be walked step-by-step through the setup.
