## Will this change impact me? Do I need to make any changes?

With this new domain change, you'll have the option to use a different (and easier) URL to access the website.

However, the old URL will continue to work as well, so there will be no changes necessary on your end.

#### Will links that I've saved or bookmarked still work?

Yes, any links under the old domain will redirect to the new domain, so you won't need to re-save any links.

# Is the company name changing too?

The company name is not changing - just the domain (or URL).
