Will this change impact me? Do I need to make any changes?

With this new domain change, you'll have the option to use a different (and easier) URL to access the website.

However, the old URL will continue to work as well, so there will be no changes necessary on your end.

Will links that I've saved or bookmarked still work?

Yes, any links under the old domain will redirect to the new domain, so you won't need to re-save any links.

Is the company name changing too?

The company name is not changing - just the domain (or URL).
